### Antibody Testing for Syphilis

Corewell Health is seeing a large number of denials, especially for patients with Blue Cross or Medicare coverage, where Syphilis Antibody testing is being ordered but diagnosis coding that supports medical necessity is not present.

## When Syphilis Testing is Medically Supported

✓ Asymptomatic High-Risk Individuals (Other codes may be available, this is only a sample)

- Z72.51 High risk heterosexual behavior
- Z72.52 High risk homosexual behavior
- Z72.53 High risk bisexual behavior
- Z72.89 Other problems related to lifestyle
- ✓ Asymptomatic Individuals only when one of the following criteria
  is met:
  - Newborn screening.
  - Follow up on victim of sexual assault.
  - Sexually Active Individuals UNDER the age of 18.

#### ✓ Symptomatic Individuals

## When Syphilis Testing Is NOT Medically Supported

Ø Asymptomatic Individuals that do not meet an exception outlined above.

### Ø Pregnant Women who are not High Risk\*

\*Medicare allows for one screening test during pregnancy with both the screening diagnosis code and supervision of pregnancy code.
